- Attend all staff training/orientation and meetings
- Participate in the Summer Day Camp mentoring program for Day Camp staff and campers
- Uphold all health and safety regulations
- Work cooperatively with the Day Camp Coordinator and the Assistant Coordinator, church staff and volunteers in all aspects of the program

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Be between 15 and 30 years of age (inclusively) at the time of intake/selection
- High School or university/college student who was in school full time during the 2013-2014 school year and is returning to school full time in 2014-2015
- Able to work within a Christian atmosphere and to promote the goals of the program and the mission of the Salvation Army
- Possess leadership qualities, be organized, hardworking, dedicated and creative
- Previous experience working with children
- Works well independently and is a team player
- Willing to provide a Criminal Background Check, complete The Salvation Army's Statement of Applicant for Work with Children form and complete the Armatus Abuse Risk Management online training before camp begins
- Have or be willing to get Standard First Aid and CPR
- Be available for full 9 weeks of program
- Be able to provide 2 references, 1 from an employer/supervisor and 1 from a family friend/Pastor
